Frequently Asked Questions related to the Fair Access process at Kensington Community and Aquatic Recreation Centre.

1. Will factors outside of my organisation control be taken into consideration when being assessed for venue hire?

We understand that there are factors that are out of your control, and therefore these will be taken into consideration when reviewing your application. Our aim is to work with organisations, not "catch them out".

2. "Demonstrate connection of participants to the City of Melbourne"How much detail is required to respond?

This question is mainly about your physical footprint and where your participants live. Please also provide any community programs you may run in the City of Melbourne.

3. Is the Annual Inclusion Self-Assessment rated?

The self-assessment is not rated and we encourage organisations to provide genuine responses. The information provided will help identify the training and support required to increase the diversity of participation in the City of Melbourne.

4. Is it possible that my organisation will not be provided an allocated space if we do not meet all of the Championing Gender Equality and Fair Access indicators?

Primary access will be provided for groups that comply with the criteria. When all groups that have complied are offered allocated space, we will then proceed to the groups that do not meet all Championing Gender Equality and Fair Access indicators.

5. When can we expect the facility to open for community use? The facility is expected to reopen in mid-2025.
